

SYNOPSIS SHORT

Russian war in Ukraine turns houses into dust and the dead into numbers. In the midst of the ongoing invasion, new structures of care are emerging to protect those who're alive and recover those who aren't. Unvarnished and unforgiving, DEAR BEAUTIFUL BELOVED documents this tireless work, which must never become a normality.



SYNOPSIS LONG

"For the first time in my life I have such a journey." explains an old woman. Together with those who are ill or alone, who can no longer walk or see, she sits on a train that is supposed to take her out of the war and to safety. "As long as this is not your last journey. That's all that matters," she's told.

Even beyond the front line, Russian war pervades Ukraine, reshaping the daily lives of the population through its violent omnipresence. As a response to these challenges, new structures of care are emerging within society: the elderly, single and immobile people are evacuated; improvised shelters and infirmaries are set up; escape routes are collectively organized; corpses are recovered, so that they can be identified and delivered to their relatives. Amidst all the efforts, moments of despair arise: Who will be left behind? Which families will be torn apart? When will it all end? How can we ever recover?

As a contemporary document, DEAR BEAUTIFUL BELOVED looks at survival strategies when the state of emergency has become routine. In doing so, it creates visibility for the moments of solicitude, systems of care-work and the continuous attempts to protect lives and return dignity to the people from whom it was violently taken. Unvarnished and unforgiving, but honest and hopeful, DEAR BEAUTIFUL BELOVED documents this tireless work, which must never become a normality.

Juri Rechinsky (1986) is a director, editor, producer and writer. He grew up in Kyiv and is living in Vienna since 2013. His documentary SICKFUCKPEOPLE (75', 2013, Novotny Film), his feature film UGLY (92', 2017, Novotny Film/ Pronto Film/ Ulrich Seidl Film) and his documentary SIGNS OF WAR (85 min, 2022, fragile features) have been shown at IFF Rotterdam, Hot Docs, Sao Paolo Mostra, DOK Leipzig. Winner of several awards including Heart of Sarajevo, Raindance, Viennale, European Independent Film Festival and DocsDF Mexico. Member of the European Film Academy and Austrian Guild of Directors.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

"When I woke up after three hours of sleep, the first thing I thought of were the 12 corpses behind me. They all smelled bad, all of them dead. I was soaked with those smells and those liquids, and there was still a long road ahead. It was terribly cold, I didn't know when I could get back to comfort. In the morning, we arrived at the morgue. It was utterly clogged with naked bodies, some of them dissected, some sewn up. I looked at those bodies and suddenly realized that each one of them was awaited at home."
